MASSIVE WIN FOR RTBU MEMBERS JOB SECURITY

With the announcement of the new ticketing system, the RTBU has been fighting for guarantees from the Victorian Government regarding Job Security for our members who perform a variety of ticketing functions and roles at Metro, V/Line and Yarra Trams.

On 15 June 2023 an RTBU delegation consisting of Vik Sharma RTBU State Secretary, Union Officials and RTBU Delegates representing frontline staff from the different operators met with the Minister for Public Transport Ben Carroll for an open and frank conversation about the threat a modern ticketing system poses to members' jobs.

RTBU delegates spoke about the serious concerns that members have regarding their jobs and the impact that this would have on their families and were able to provide direct examples from the shop floor about the importance of their roles.
